

STEPS FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE GRADUATE NURSING PROGRAM

- Apply for admission to the Graduate School. Go to <http://gradschool.louisiana.edu/> for **Downloadable Forms**, **Online Application**, and **Important Information about the Graduate Application for Admission**.
- Take the Graduate Records Examination (GRE) General Test (verbal, quantitative, and analytical writing sections) at least six weeks prior to the beginning of the semester you plan to enroll.
- Information about the GRE is available at <http://www.GRE.org/>
- Request that official transcripts be sent from the Registrar of all schools you have attended (except UL Lafayette) to the UL Lafayette Graduate School, PO Box 44610, Lafayette, LA, 70504-4610
- Once the Graduate School has received your application, official GRE scores, and official transcripts (if applicable), they will determine if you have met the criteria for admission.
- The Graduate School will send your application packet to the MSN Program Coordinator for acceptance into the MSN program.
- You will be notified by the Graduate School of your acceptance and will be directed to contact your academic advisor to schedule courses.
- Call the Graduate Nursing Coordinator (337-482-5617) to schedule an appointment for academic advising.
- Take the signed academic advisement form to the Graduate School, Martin Hall room 332.
- You may wish to call the Graduate School at (337) 482-6965 to obtain information about dates and times for registration.
- You must maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average to remain eligible to continue taking graduate courses.
